Fifteen license types.
One connected process.

Clear requirements for businesses. Connected evidence for staff. Accessible services for the public.

Different businesses. Different requirements.

One Commission serves the motor vehicle trade and manufactured housing.

APPLICATIONS

The right evidence

Each license type has its own requirements for people, premises, documents, and fees.

ONGOING OBLIGATIONS

Work beyond licensing

Businesses change owners, register personnel, move locations, and file industry reports.

Applicants need a clear path. Staff need the filing and its supporting evidence.

Show what applies. Keep the work together.

One application process serves all fifteen business license types.

01	Start with the requirements	Instructions, forms, and the fee are shown for the selected license type.
02	Follow the relevant steps	The application displays the steps that apply to that business.
03	Save the filing and its evidence	Applicants can resume work. Documents are labeled by their purpose.

Clear guidance for applicants. Evidence in context for staff.

Support the work after approval.

Businesses can handle ongoing regulatory transactions through the portal.

BUSINESS CHANGES

Submit updates

File location, name, and ownership changes, plus bond and insurance updates.

PEOPLE

Manage registrations

Register salespersons and cardholders, pay in batches, and manage authorized representatives.

CREDENTIALS

Print and verify

Print approved license certificates and principal wallet cards with QR links to public verification.

One account gives a representative access to the businesses they serve.

Make recurring work easier to complete.

Guided filings connect industry reporting and inspector applications to Commission intake.

INSTALLATION REPORTS

Apply the fee rule

Installers file reports online. The selected home type determines whether a fee applies.

SHIPMENT REPORTS

Record the month

Fees are calculated from shipment details. A month with no shipments can still be filed.

INSPECTOR APPLICATIONS

Deliver a familiar form

Inspectors apply and sign online. Staff receive the signed Commission form and supporting documents.

Reporting details and supporting evidence travel with the work.

Let people take the first step themselves.

Public verification, complaint intake, and records requests require no account.

VERIFY A LICENSE

Check the live record

Search business and individual licenses and print a verification record.

START A FILING

Provide the context

Submit a complaint linked to a selected business or request public records with a reference number.

Information and intake are available directly to the public.

Connect the transaction to the record.

The filing, its evidence, and its payment each have a clear place in the process.

Delivered capability	Practical value
Structured business filings	Staff receive answers and labeled documents together.
State-hosted payment service	Business applicants can pay by card or eCheck.
Processor-confirmed payments	Payment is checked before a filing is marked paid.
Individual or combined invoice payment	Businesses can settle one invoice or several in one transaction.

Routine transactions run online. Regulatory decisions remain with the Commission.
